### Stop Teen Dating Abuse Before It Starts

If you had to guess, how many young adults in your community truly feel safe in their relationships? Of those who say they feel safe, how many do you think can truly recognize the difference between caring, supportive relationships and controlling, manipulative abusive ones?

The prevalence of teen dating violence in your community may surprise you. In the US alone:

- About one in 12 high school students experienced physical dating violence (Centers for Disease Control)
- One in 12 also say they've experienced sexual dating violence (Centers for Disease Control)
- 26.6% of LGBTQ students and 14.1% of heterosexual students have been electronically bullied (Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System)

Shifting community norms begins with in-depth awareness and education. 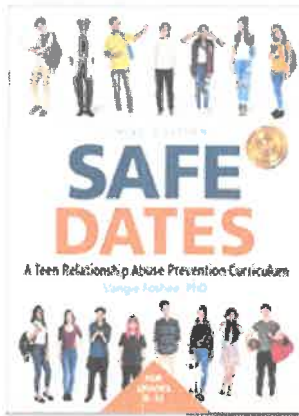
